Rules of Play for 50/50 Electronic Raffle:

1. The lottery will take place online and through mail July 13, 2020 to September 7, 2020 with an early bird draw taking place on August 7, 2020.
2. All tickets will only be sold to people who are 18 years of age or older.
3. Must be in the province of Ontario at the time of purchase.
4. Tickets are 3 for \$5, 10 for \$10 or 60 for \$20
5. Tickets will be available online at riverside5050.ca or by mailing a ticket order form to 110 Victoria Ave, Fort Frances, ON, P9A 2B7. Ticket order forms will be mailed to all households and businesses in the Riverside Health Care Facilities catchment area that have opted in to our mailer and will be available online at www.riverside5050.ca.
6. Tickets will be sold using electronic raffle system supplied by Ascend Fundraising Solutions.
7. After buying tickets online, patrons will receive a confirmation e-mail with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Number Generator. After buying tickets through the mail, physical tickets with 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Number Generator will be printed using a handheld device provided by Ascend. The Physical ticket(s) will be mailed to mail in purchasers. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly.
8. The winning ticket number will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw.
9. Tickets will be sold beginning at 9:00am on July 13, 2020 and ending at 5:00pm on September 7, 2020. All tickets purchased between July 13, 2020 at or after 9:00am and August 7, 2020 at or before 8:59am will be entered into the early bird prize draw. All tickets purchased between July 13, 2020 at or after 9:00am and September 7th, 2020 at or before 5:00pm will be entered into the grand prize draw. It is possible for the same number to win both the early bird prize and the grand prize.
10. The draw for the early bird prize will take place August 7, 2020 at 9:00am.
 - a. August 7, 2020 Early Bird Prize: The Early Bird Prize is a Fishing Package for Two - Courtesy of Manitou Weather Station Fishing Lodge. Package will include lodging for 3 nights, meals, and guided fishing 2 days. It must be taken in the summer of 2021 and is non-transferrable. The total retail value for this package is \$2,203.50. (\$1950.00 + HST).
11. The grand prize draw will take place on September 7, 2020 at 5:00pm.
9. The amount of the 50/50 will be displayed at www.riverside5050.ca and www.riversidefoundation.ca

10. The winning number will be announced online at www.riverside5050.ca, www.riversidefoundation.ca, on the Riverside Foundation for Health Care Facebook page, in the Fort Frances Times and on B93 Radio Station.
11. The winner may claim their prize by contacting Riverside Foundation for Health Care at: (807) 274-4803, or by email at: allison.cox@rhcf.on.ca. The ticket may then be brought to 110 Victoria Ave, Fort Frances, ON at an agreed upon time for ticket verification. The winner will then be paid by cheque for the amount posted at the event for which they bought their ticket. Winners must have the original winning ticket and no copies. **All payments will be made by cheque.**
12. The winning ticket holder has **6 months** in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchase for.
13. The winner must provide his/her name, address, and phone number with picture identification for our report sheet.
14. Once the certified winner is verified, and provides identification with photo ID, they will be given a cheque in the amount of the declared prize which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that draw. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.
15. In the event that no winner comes forward, the winning stub will kept in a safety deposit box and held for 6 months. After that time period has elapsed the prize will be donated to a charity other than Riverside Foundation for Health Care with the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).
16. The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the 50/50 draws:
Any paid employees of Riverside Foundation for Health Care and any volunteers that sit on the Riverside Foundation for Health Care Board of Directors or Special Events Committee.
